After settling into comfortable safari-style tents, guests will enjoy a delicious buffet dinner before setting off on an exclusive behind the scenes night safari. Spend an hour and a half with passionate keepers and guides who will take guests on a once in a lifetime tour through Taronga after dark.

Arise to the sounds of Taronga at dawn and be greeted by sparkling Sydney Harbour views when they step out from their tents to experience two exclusive behind the scenes animal encounters, followed by a continental breakfast.

WHAT TO BRING

Enclosed shoes—Taronga Sydney's landscape is varied and your experience will include walking. Heels, sandals and thongs are not recommended

Wet weather gear - Roar and Snore is an all-weather experience. Guests should come prepared for any inclement weather

Toiletries – The Roar and Snore campsite has shower and bathroom facilities (Taronga will provide bed linen and bath towels)

CAMPSITE INFORMATION

- 17 tents on site / maximum 44 pax per night
- Tents are configured with a double bed and 2 x single trundle beds (maximum 4 per tent)
- All tents have power supply, electric lighting, electric blankets (on double beds only) and additional blankets for cooler months
- Shared bathroom amenities are located at the camp site. Please note there are no bathtubs

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

- Roar & Snore is a hosted group program that starts at 6:15pm and runs until 9:30am the next day. There is minimal flexibility for guests to depart the program prior to 9:30am. Please ensure any following flight and/or activities bookings do not have a pick up time prior to 9:30am.
- Valid photo identification matching the quests name on their reservation is required on arrival
- Roar and Snore and Taronga Sydney is a smoke-free zone.
- Due to the wide-ranging itinerary and landscape of the Taronga Sydney site, all children must be a minimum of 5 years old to attend. Guests may be requested to provide proof of age if the child does not look to be of age 5
- A variety beer, wine and non-alcoholic drinks are included with meals. No additional alcohol may be brought onto Taronga Sydney. Guests must be 18 years old and carry ID
- Taronga reserves the right to cancel Roar and Snore programs at any time due to unforeseen circumstances such as natural disasters or insufficient demand
