Appearance

Red Kangaroos have strong back legs, a long tail and a small head. Males are usually red, and females are more grey.

Red kangaroos live in deserts and grasslands. Kangaroos rest in the shade during the day and come out when it is cooler.

Red Kangaroos eat grasses and plants. They can get most of their water from the food they eat.

Predators


Dingoes and eagles can hunt young joeys. Cars and drought also make life harder for kangaroos.

Behaviour

Kangaroos hop fast using their back legs and tail. They live in groups called mobs. Mothers carry their tiny joeys in a pouch. Females can delay having a baby if there is not enough food.

Red Kangaroos are strong and special animals, and protecting their habitat helps keep them safe.
