

# Billabong Camp



## Camper's Guide

### What to bring with you:

- Toiletries – Toilets and showers are located on site.
- Clothing – Billabong Camp is an all-weather program. Please bring clothing suited to a variety of conditions, including wet and cold weather.
- Camera and torch (torch with red light preferable).
- Closed in shoes, suitable for walking on tour.
- Billabong Camp is a no BYO event. Alcohol and merchandise are available for purchase. EFTPOS and credit card facilities are available.

### We provide:

- 3m x 3m tents equipped with two stretcher beds with mattresses and a sleeping mat. Linen is provided, as are sleeping bags, pillows and towels.
- Nibbles on arrival
- BBQ buffet dinner
- Tea, coffee and sweet supper snack
- Continental buffet breakfast
- Two day Zoo admission
- 10 % off at Zoo Café & Bar;
- 10 % off at Zoo Shop; and
- 10 % off additional Animal Encounters

## Sample itinerary:

### Day 1

From 9am on the day of your stay: Arrive at Taronga Western Plains Zoo and check in at the Savannah Visitor Plaza. Grab a map and schedule of our free daily Keeper Activities, and start exploring the Zoo.

Between 3:30pm – 5pm: Make your way to Billabong Camp. Meet your host at the Billabong Camp site, where you will be welcomed and given time to settle into your tent.

5.00pm: Relax by the billabong with drinks and nibbles.

6.45pm: Feast on an outback BBQ buffet dinner, to fuel up before your night walk.

8:00pm: Grab your cameras, jumpers and water bottles before heading to the Aussie Walkthrough. Immerse yourself in the Australian bush whilst you search for native animals by spotlight.

8.45pm: Enjoy supper under the stunning night sky.

10.00pm: Turn out the lights and retire for the evening.

### Day 2

6.15-7.00am: Start the day with a filling continental breakfast.

Approx 8.45am: Arrive back at Billabong Camp.

9.00am: Check out and explore the Zoo at your leisure.

Your stay at Billabong Camp includes two-day admission to Taronga Western Plains Zoo, so you can arrive anytime from 9am on the day of your stay and explore the Zoo prior to meeting your host at Billabong Camp.

On arrival at the Zoo, please check in at the Information Desk in the Savannah Visitor Plaza. Our friendly staff will provide you with a map and instructions on how to get to Billabong Camp.

You will need to be on the Zoo circuit by 4:00pm to make your way around to Billabong Camp where your host will greet you.
