Kit List – items you need to bring with you

- 🐾 Camera.
- 🐾 Toiletries - showers are available, toilets within walking distance and open all night.
- 🐾 Roar and Snore is an all-weather program. Bring wet-weather gear.
- 🐾 Enclosed Shoes (Heels, Sandals or Thongs not recommended)

We provide:

- 🐾 Tents are 2-4 person tents (you won't have to sleep with anyone you don't know).
- 🐾 All linen and towels.
- 🐾 Meals:
 - Refreshments & nibbles on arrival.
 - Buffet Dinner (vegetarian option available every evening).
 - Tea, coffee and sweet snack.
 - Continental breakfast.
- 🐾 Complimentary parking (multistorey car park only)

Where & when to meet:

At the Roar and Snore Meeting point. Enter via the main Zoo car park. The meeting point is via the main gate which is adjacent to the car park. Taronga Zoo is approximately 15 minutes by ferry from Circular Quay (Ferries depart Circular Quay every quarter past and quarter to the hour). A STA bus meets each Ferry, the first stop being the Zoo's Top Entrance. It will not be possible to enter via the Lower Entrance.

- 🐾 Start time – 6:15 pm
- 🐾 Finish time – 9:00 – 9:30 am

- 7:30 am Behind-the-scenes tours x 2.
- 9-9.30 am Finish (you can spend the day in the Zoo if you wish).
